JQ99 Team Dates: March 16-23, 2009

*****This opportunity is limited to 20 JQ99 listeners and only to those who have not previously ministered with Paradise Bound in Guatemala.***

Experience includes: Roundtrip airfare and all taxes from the nearest major airport (at our discretion), ground transportation in Guatemala; Program expenses; Devotions (led by our staff); Modern housing w/beds, bedding, private bathrooms, and hot showers (most of the time); Purified water (bring your own empty water bottle), Three American style meals/day.

Not covered: 1 or 2 meals might be eaten at a restaurant, your additional cost would be \$5.00 to \$7.00/meal/person. Souvenirs you may wish to purchase.

Cost: \$1250.00 / Person. TRIP COSTS ARE TAX DEDUCTIBLE (Consult your tax adviser)

- A non-refundable deposit of \$100/person is required to hold your ministry date.

- Remaining \$1,150 is due no later than January 25, 2009. If full payment is not received by January 25th (unless prior arrangements have been made), we may be forced by the airlines to remove your name from the team.

Please note that this payment schedule is set according to airline deadlines. If payments are not made on time, though we will do everything we can, you may lose your reservations.

If God has called you to be a part of His incredible plan for Guatemala, he will provide the means! Many write family and friends for support. If others give toward your trip, they should write the checks out to Paradise Bound, but send them to you. You can then send them to us in one envelope assuring each is credited to you.

Deadline: January 31, 2009, but don't wait! This team will fill very quickly!

More Stuff

Passports: A current US Passport is required for travel to Guatemala. This can take several months to acquire, start early...less stress is good!

Shots: We highly recommend: Hepatitis A & B, and Tetanus. Start early as Hep A&B can take up to 6 months for the 3 shots.

Malaria, typhoid, and or other vaccinations are a decision between you and your physician. You will be working in the regions usually classified as non-malaria. All food and water will be handled by our staff.

Age Recommendations: Young or young at heart, we do not set the age, but do ask the following; Those under 16 should be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. For those a little more aged; though our schedule can be intense, you are given the freedom to rest as needed. We are here to take care of you also, and part of that is allowing you an incredible mission experience while working at the pace you can handle comfortably. Most importantly, age does not matter, what matters is if you feel called to be a part of this team!

Home Building & Medicine Costs: Each home constructed, usually 4 or 5 per team costs us \$1,000/ea in materials. This cost is not part of the \$1,250/person. However, the funds to provide a home to an impoverished family will be the easiest you'll ever have the blessing to raise. This fundraising will be accomplished as a team and with the help of the JQ99 family.

For your teams Mobile Medical Clinics, we will utilize approximately \$2,400. of medicines in the remote villages. Again this is our cost, but the fair market value of these meds exceeds \$24,000!!! Yea, you will change and save lives!!! As a team this can also be raised and/or our supporters can help. God will provide for you, but most importantly for those He will save during your stay with us!

Communications now and while in Guatemala: It is always best to email us info@paradisebound.org as it is the most assured form of communication in Guatemala. If we are in the middle of a current team, it may take several days for us to reply. Once in Guatemala we encourage you to leave your phones in your suitcases as most of them do not work anyway or cost several dollars/min. We have an office phone/fax, and have cell phones with us at all times. Your family can communicate with us if need be. A website will be set up to post your indescribable pictures and experiences so family members and friends can share in what God is doing!

In Closing:

*We recognize and embrace the incredible potential of each team & each team member God ordains to send our way. Your time with us will not be wasted. We know what needs to be accomplished and how God, through you, can accomplish it! In our hearts, you and your team are as much a part of Paradise Bound as we are!
